


LOVE KUWAIT JOIN THE LOVE-OLUTION

Lesson 4 “The Fruit of Love” Luke 15:11-24 – The Prodigal Son 1 Cor. 13:1-13 – Love Chapter

Group Opener: *(Choose a question for your life group to discuss.)*

1. Describe a time when you (or someone else) was hurt (or abandoned) by another person. What were the circumstances surrounding the circumstances? Who helped you? How did you feel?
2. Describe a time when someone helped you when you least expected (or deserved) it? How did it make you feel?

 **Group Facilitator** – *It is not necessary to use all the questions. Select ones that will stimulate the most response from your small group.*

1. What happens when we use our talents, gifts and abilities out of a sense of duty/obligation rather a heart of love?
2. How does ministry look different when we do it out of love rather than in our own strength and effort?
3. What do you do to ensure your heart is filled with God’s love and overflowing to others? What causes that love stream to dry up?
4. How do you check to see if your heart is full of God’s love?
5. How did the father demonstrate sacrificial love to the prodigal son?
6. How have people (parents, pastors, friends, family) demonstrated sacrificial love to you? Could you tell when the sacrifice was done in love versus personal obligation?
7. What helps you see past the problems facing the needy with eyes of love?
8. What can you do to see the wounded “a long way off” and seek out ways to share God’s love with them?
9. Name some of the fruit of Love and loving people?
10. What does it mean that Jesus was the “first-fruit”? (Really the “First-fruit” of the Father’s love to this world?) What other fruit is coming?

✓ **Selah (Stop and Think about it):** *(Take the time to make personal application of this section. Have each member share with the group.)*

- What is God speaking to you (personally & specifically) from the story of the Prodigal Son?
- How can we demonstrate the father’s love to the prodigals around us?

- Share a couple of testimonies of how your group members are extending God's Love to people here in Kuwait.
- Encourage your group members to bring as many people as they can to the Good Friday Services and the Easter Sunrise Service. We are believing for the biggest crowds we have ever had for these services. We want as many people as possible to hear the resurrection message.
