


ON THE ROAD TO EMMAUS LUKE 24:13-35

Group Opener: *(Choose a question for your life group to discuss.)*

1. If you lost your job today, where would you go for help and encouragement?
2. What has been one of the biggest surprises of your life?

 **Group Facilitator** – *It is not necessary to use all the questions. Select ones that will stimulate the most response from your small group.*

1. What are some of the things that the two disciples are talking about as they walked along the road? (vv. 19-24) What is the tone of their conversation? How do they respond to Jesus when they first encounter him in this passage?
2. From your knowledge of Old Testament prophecy, what passages might Jesus have discussed with these two men in verses 25-27? Why do you think Jesus did not immediately reveal His identity to them?
3. How does the time at the dinner open their eyes? (vv. 30-31) What happens to Jesus when they recognize Him? Why do you think He leaves?
4. What might be some reasons that Jesus made a special appearance to Simon Peter? (v. 34)

✓ **Selah (Stop and Think about it):** *(Take the time to make personal application of this section. Have each member share with the group.)*

- What is God speaking to you (personally & specifically) from this passage?
- Where is your “Road to Emmaus” – the place where Jesus surprised you recently? What happened?
- How well do you think you can explain the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and the way a person can have a relationship with Him?
- What strategies do you know of that can be used to share your faith with another person? (i.e. Romans Road, Bridge Illustration or Four Spiritual Laws)
- Who do you know that you can talk with this week about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ?
